SANTA CLARITA, Calif., March 23, 2008 -- CARe, Inc. (Community Assisted Recovery), a non-profit organization that provides free information and disaster recovery counseling to victims of a natural disaster, focusing primarily on insurance claims and construction issues, invites homeowners and others affected by last October's Santa Clarita Valley wildfires to a special meeting starting 10 a.m. Saturday, March 29, at the SCV Senior Center.

CARe counselors have already assisted many families who were affected by the Santiago Canyon, Corral Canyon (Malibu) and San Diego County fires.
